Dear Yves,

This is a strong recommendation for an indefinite appointment for Daryl DiBitonto. So far I have taken the point of view that indefinite appointments should be given as parsimoniously as possible. However, in the case of Daryl I believe one should make an exception.

As a graduate student working at the ISR he has been the first to show that Charm was abundantly produced with the LSM-detector. Already at that time he had shown clearly remarkable determination, persistence and unique ability in pulling hard physics out of the data. At present he is the main driving force behind diffractive production studies of heavy flavours at the collider.

His competence of hardware is equally extensive : during the construction of UA1 he has contributed to the high voltage system for the central detector. This task is not easy since the device is complicated and of delicate operation. His work has been excellent.

Of very pleasant character, he is somewhat hindered by his timidity. I would say that he is definitely one of these persons for which the second impression is better than the first. As far as leadership is concerned, he seems to know how to provide it whenever it seems to be lacking. However I must say that so far he did not have much of an opportunity in the UA1 group!
